

Research internship CELA

Wintertuin is a literary organisation based in Nijmegen that organises festivals, literary programming and workshops revolving around the theme of fiction as our guide. We also offer emerging writers a space for experiment and a platform for exchange. We coach them in the development of an autonomous professional practice. Wintertuin has an online literary platform: [De Notulen van het Onzichtbare](#). And we publish chapbooks and other books.

In our international project [CELA](#), Connecting Emerging Literary Artists, we offer writers, translators and literary professionals a space for exchange and collaboration across borders and language barriers.

Wintertuin is offering a research internship (x/f/m) for the period September 2023 to February 2024 to support the international project CELA in its final phase.

Our interns are an integral part of our organisation. They are involved in numerous projects and are expected to support our organisation practically as well as artistically. They join our weekly staff meetings and we work alongside them as colleagues.

The work consists of meetings, brainstorming sessions, writing e-mails, googling, reading, but also of leaving your desk to talk to partners, and of assisting us during events.

Our interns do this under close supervision of our employees, who sit with them every two weeks to make sure the internship is working for the both of us and you feel comfortable with our organisation.

This specific internship is open to international students as well as national students.

What do we offer?

- Period: September 2023-February 2024.
- Time: 3 days a week.
- Language: the internship can be either in English or in Dutch.
- Assignment: you will be involved in supporting the project coordinator of CELA in implementing the activities of the project, talking to the partners across Europe, and supporting them in any way possible. Your specific task is to help us review the project, and support Wintertuin in reporting on it towards Creative Europe. You will do this through gathering relevant data and information and taking and analysing a survey amongst all partners and participants of the project.
- Payment: 200 euro per month, based on a 3-day internship (the fee includes possible travel costs from home to office).

We will decide on the duration, days and starting moment of the internship in close collaboration. Please send your application, consisting of a motivation (this can be in any form: a letter, a video, something different) and an up-to-date resumé to stage@wintertuin.nl.

We are looking forward to **receiving your application before June 25**. Selection (based on meetings) will take place on Wednesday July 5.
