







<u>Wintertuin</u> is a literary organisation based in Nijmegen that organises festivals, literary programming and workshops. We offer emerging writers a space for experiment and a platform for exchange. We coach them in the development of an autonomous professional practice. Additionally, we are an internationally oriented organisation that cooperates with literary partners in Europe and beyond.

In our international project <u>CELA</u>, Connecting Emerging Literary Artists, we offer 33 writers and 99 translators from 11 countries across Europe a space for exchange and collaboration across borders and language barriers.

## Wintertuin is offering an internship (x/f/m)

for the period September 2024 to February 2025 to support the international project CELA.

The work consists of meetings with Wintertuin staff, brainstorming sessions, writing e-mails, googling for relevant input and reading, but also of (online) meetings with staff from partner organisations, and of assisting us during (online and live) activities and events.

You will be involved in organising specific local activities, but also in assisting the project coordinator in organising the formal project opening, attending staff meetings, and organising the live work week with all participants and project staff (an event with 200 attendees).

You will be closely mentored and supervised by the project coordinator and project assistant, who sit with you every two weeks to make sure the internship is working for the both of us and you feel comfortable with our organisation.

This specific internship is open to international students as well as national students and can be done in either Dutch or English. The capacity to read, write and communicate in English is either way key for this internship.

## What do we offer?

- a challenging and inspiring internship for preferably 3 days a week;
- an independent and supportive role in implementing the activities of the project, talking to the partners across Europe, and supporting them in any way possible;
- the opportunity to travel with us to Turin in January for a live project assembly (exact dates: January 29 to February 2);
- an intern salary of 200 euro per month (net), based on a 3-day internship (the fee includes travel costs from home to office).
